John Audino served as a highly successful offensive skill assistant coach for numerous Division I programs as well as being a highly successful Head Coach of Football in Division III for 42 years. John was an Ivy League Assistant where he has served as the QB/WR/RB Coach along with Passing Game Coordinator at Columbia University and the University of Pennsylvania. Wherever he has coached, each of his QB's have set or broken each of the school records. While at Union College as the Offensive Coordinator, he helped lead Union to the National Championship game where Dutchmen QB Dan Stewart, set the National D3 record for consecutive games with at least one TD pass of 36 straight games. John went on to become the Head Football Coach at Union where he won a school record of 152 games, numerous Liberty League and UCAA football titles. His teams appeared in the playoffs 11 times and won 5 ECAC championships. Now the Head Football Coach at LaSalle, John has turned around the Cadet program. John has been a featured speaker at numerous State and National Clinics.
